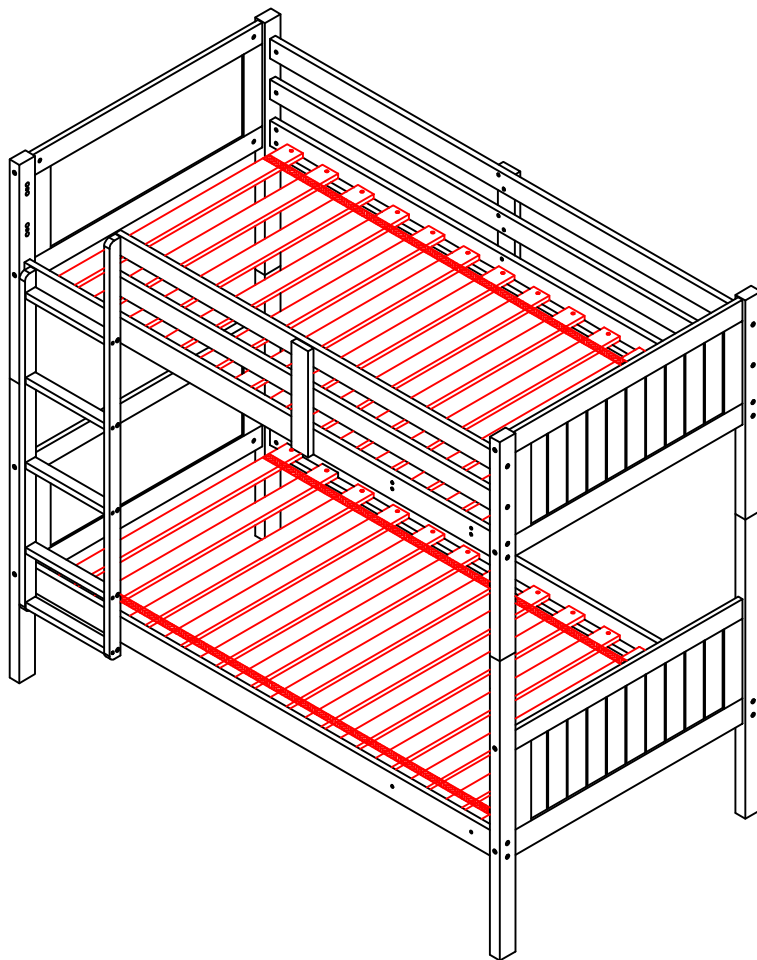

Assembly Instruction



SAFETY WARNING

Read all instructions carefully before assembling this product.

1. Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.
2. Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
3. Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in. (127 mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.
4. Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
5. Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
6. Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
7. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
8. Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
9. Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
10. Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
11. Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk. If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and wall.
12. The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.
13. **STRANGULATION HAZARD**-Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to hooks, belts and jump ropes.
14. Keep these instructions for future reference.

SIZE OF MATTRESS AND FOUNDATION:

- Use only a mattress which is 74" - 75" inches long and 38" - 38 1/2" inches wide for model in 39" inches. For model in 33" inches use mattress 32 1/2 " inches wide on upper bunk.
- Ensure that the thickness of the mattress does not exceed 7" and that the mattress surface is at least 5" (127mm) below the upper edge of the guardrails.
- Use only a mattress which is 74" - 75" inches long and 38" - 38 1/2" inches wide for model in 39" inches. For model in 33" inches use mattress 32 1/2 " inches wide on lower bunk.
- Ensure that the thickness of the mattress does not exceed 7".

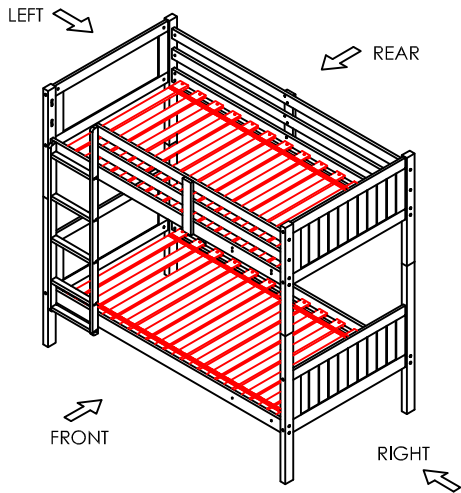

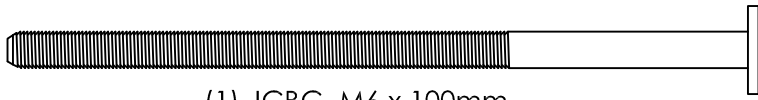
1. Remove hardware from box and sort by size.

Complete assembly for bunk bed.



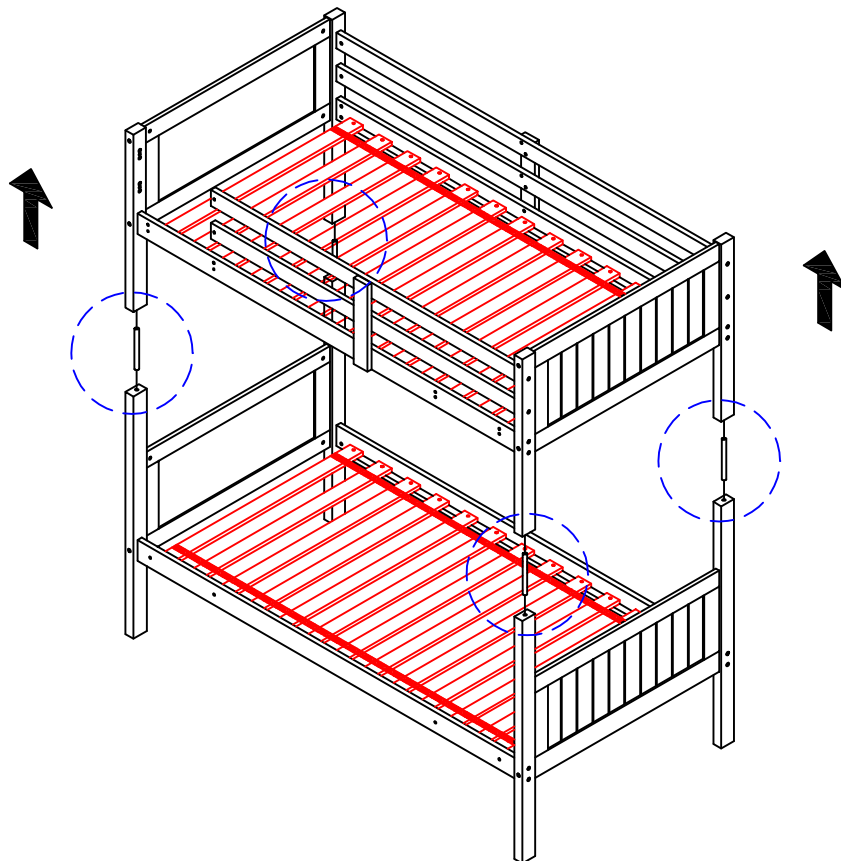

Instruction to change bunk bed into single beds.



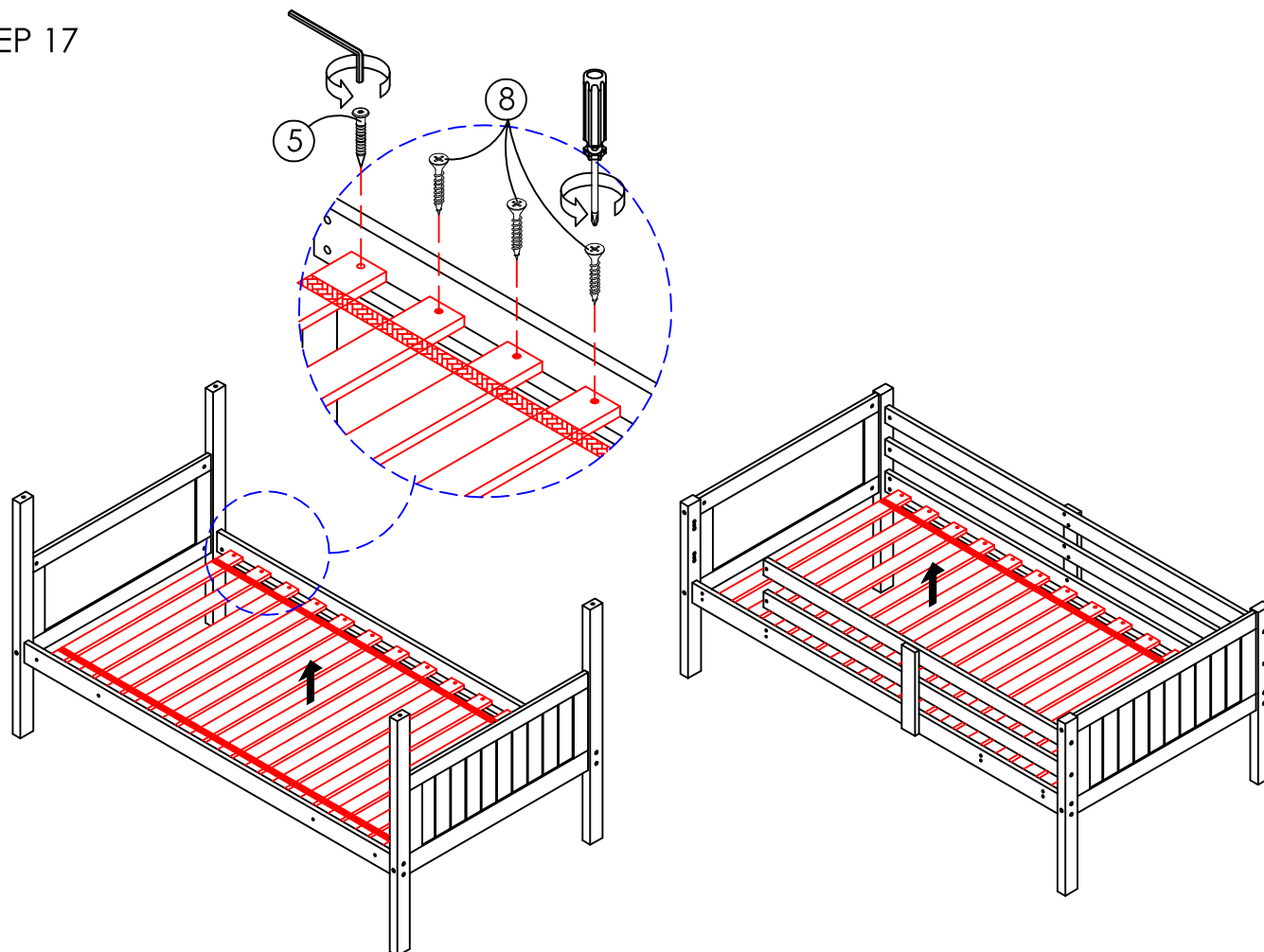
Remove the jcbc then take out the ladder from bed.

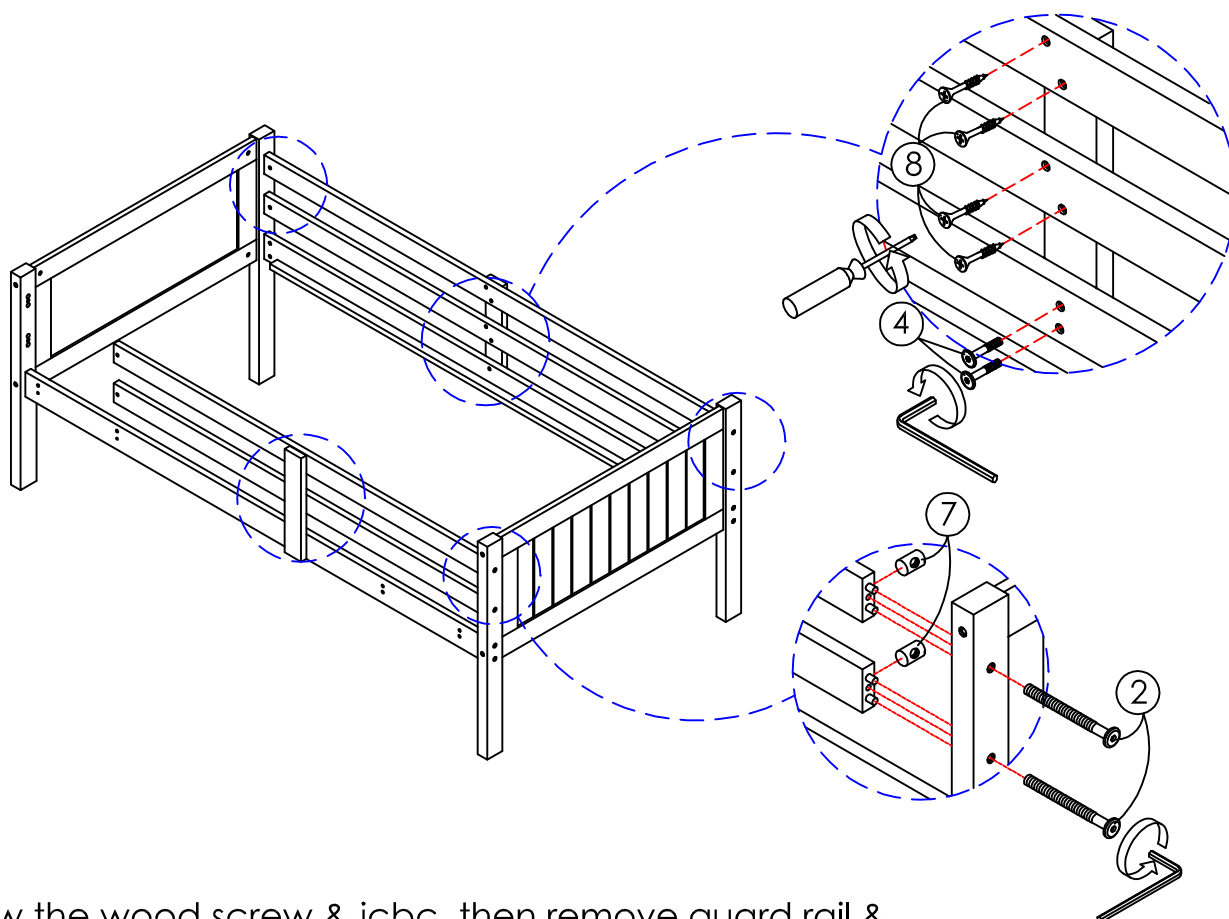
Lift the upper bed and remove metal pins.

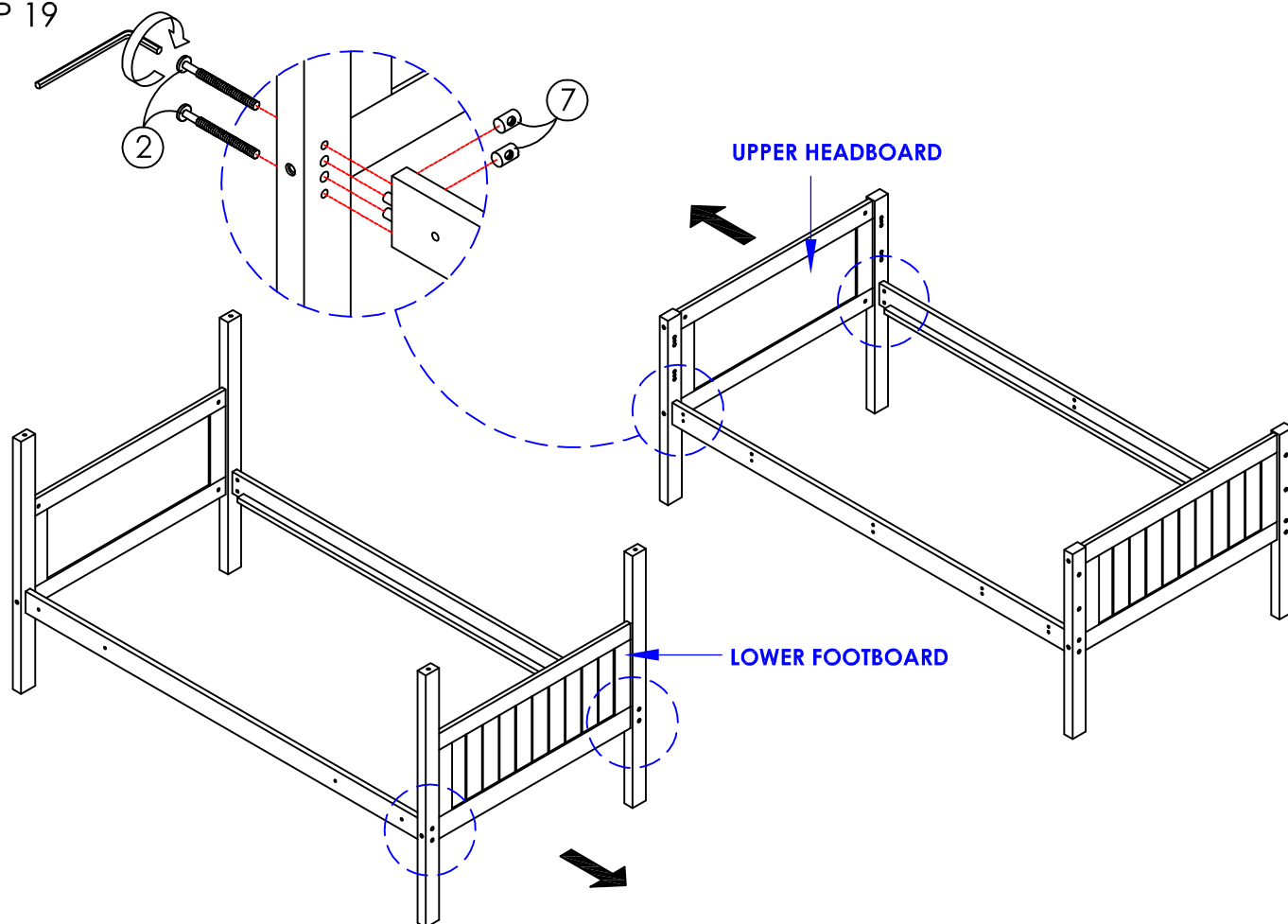
Unscrew the jcbc and wood screw, then lift the slats.

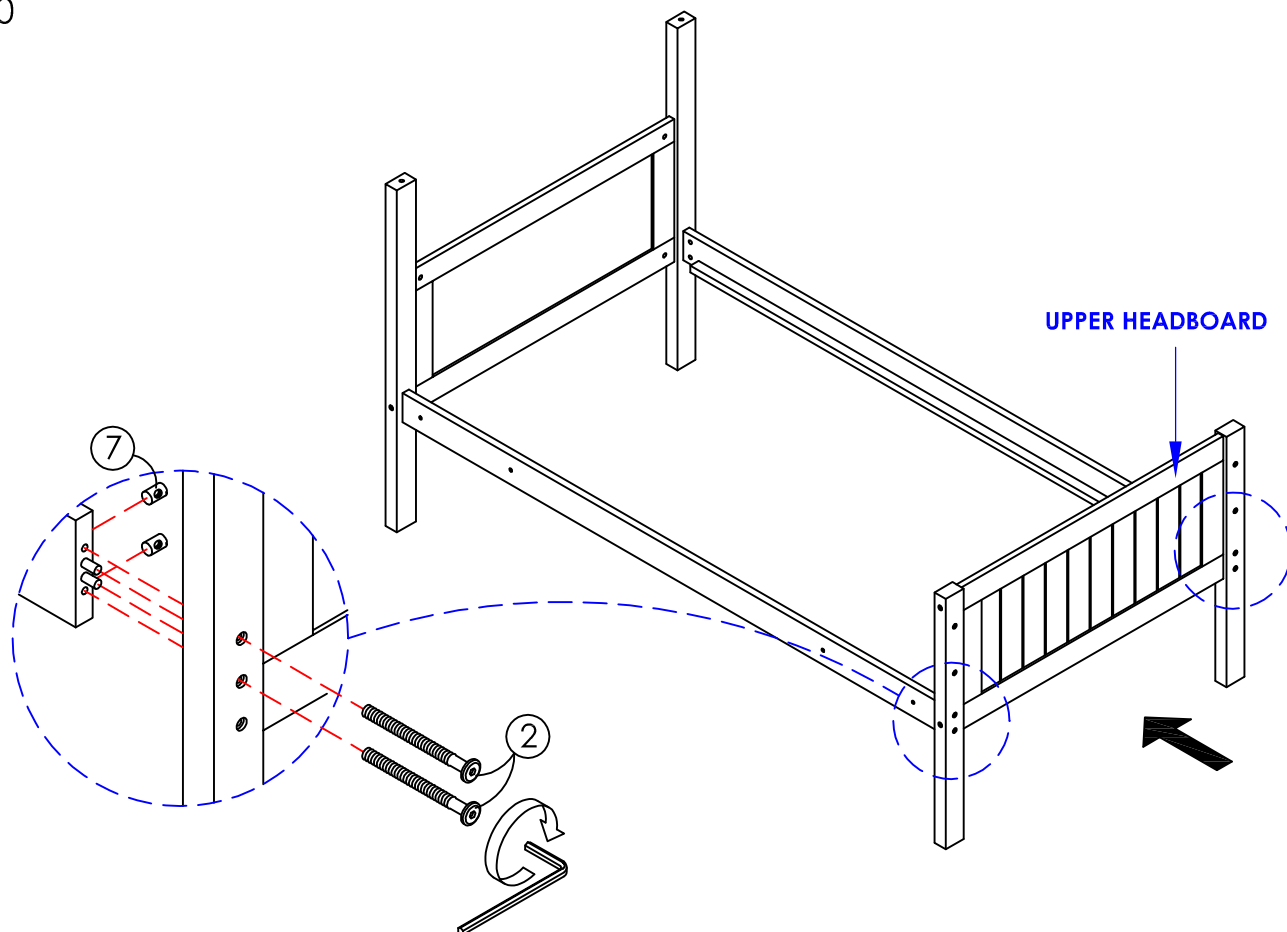
Unscrew the wood screw & jcbc, then remove guard rail & guard rail support.

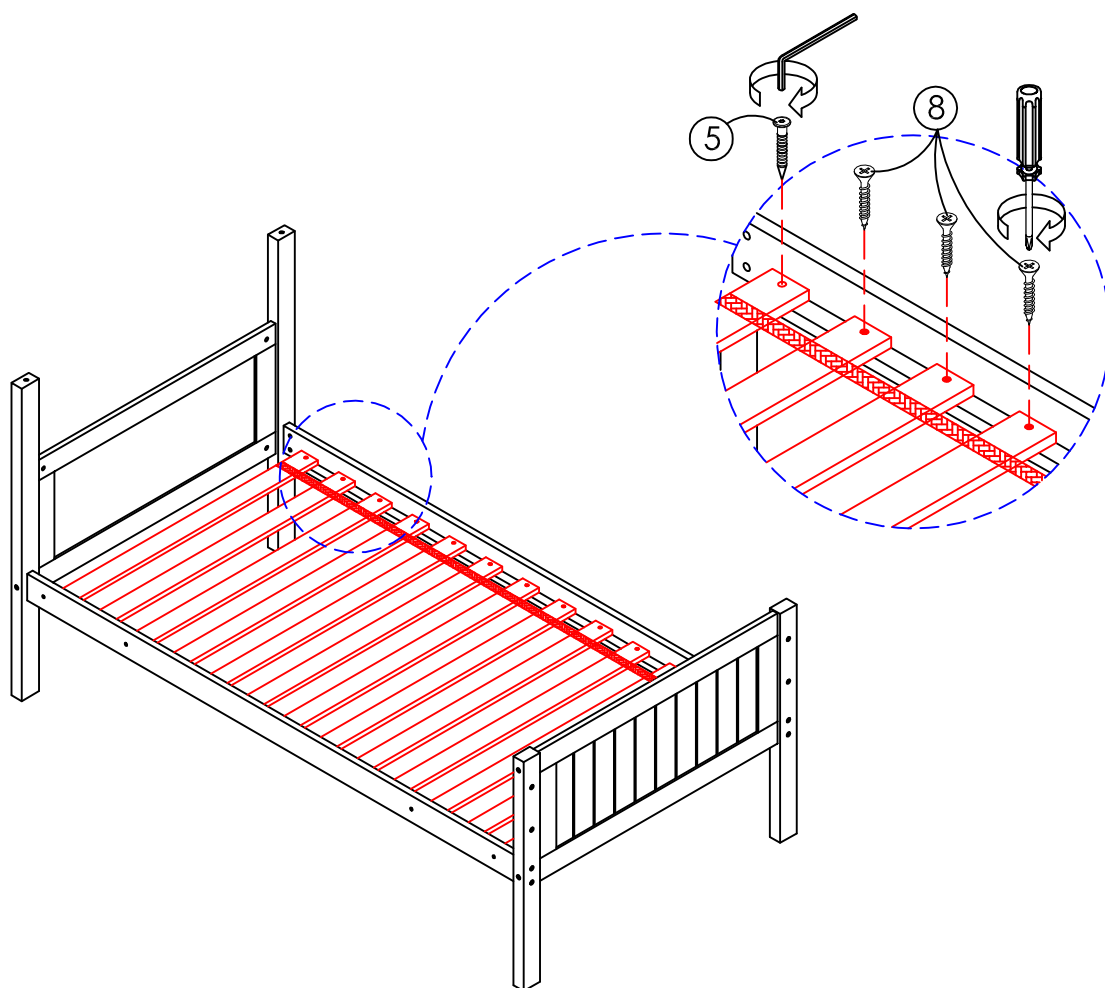
Loosen the jcbc at the upper headboard & lower footboard.

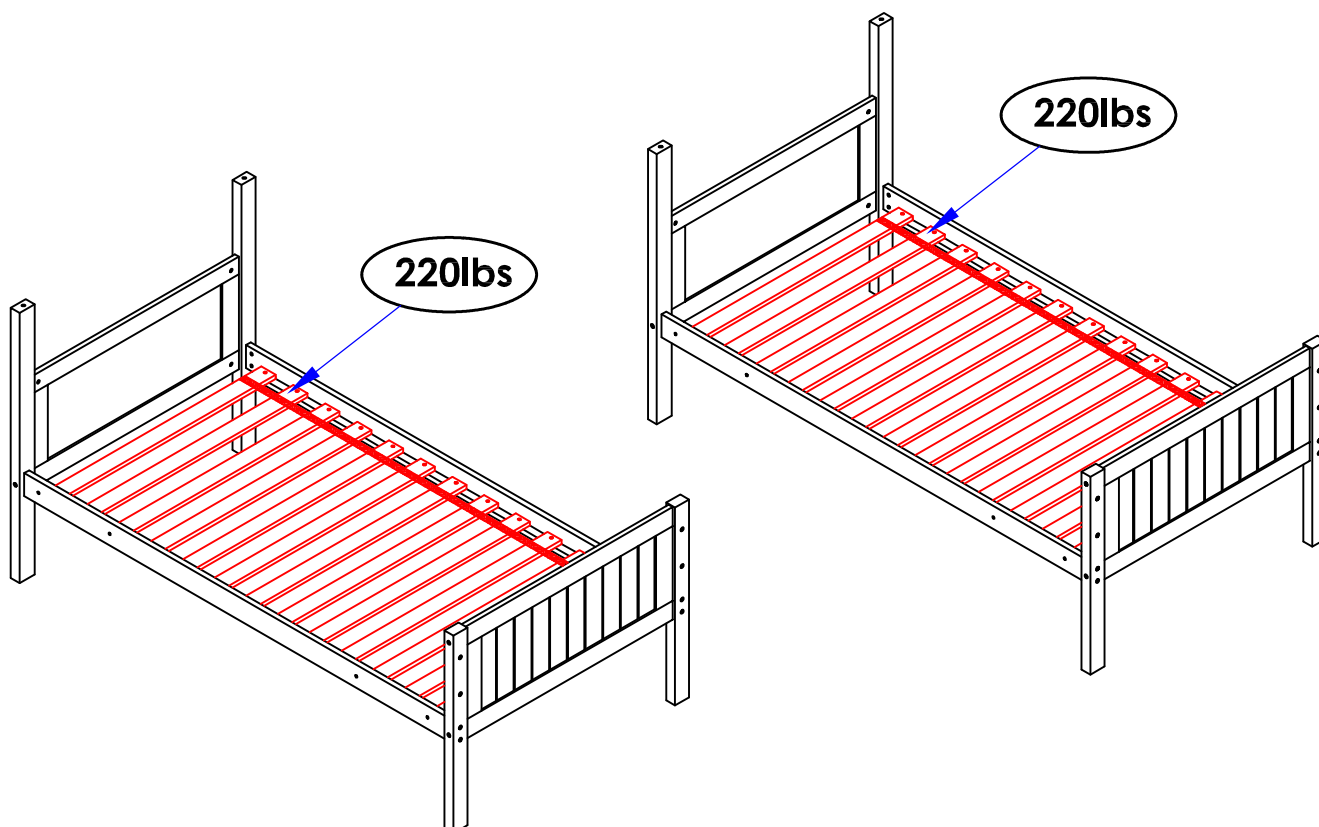
Replace the lower footboard with upper headboard as shown in picture.

STEP 22

Cleaning :

Using a clean, washable cloth made of soft, lint-free cotton, such as an old T- shirt. (The cloth should have no buttons, zippers or anything that could scratch furniture surfaces.) The fabric should be moistened with water or cleaning agent, but just enough to make dust adhere to it; if you can see any trace of liquid on the wood after you wipe, your cloth is too damp. Alternatively, you can use another cloth to remove the excess moisture.

Maintenance :

Periodic Structural Checks

The most important thing that you can do is to keep a close eye on the structure and stability of the bed. Give it a thorough once over every two-three months to check for loose, nuts, bolts and other connectors. Repair and replace any part that seems loose or faulty. This will keep the bed stable and secure at all times.
